

Internship for Undergraduate program:

Internship Criteria:

- Must be enrolled in their 3rd or 4th year of studies at Hult
- Strong extra curriculum activity during studies at Hult
- Ability to communicate fluently in written and spoken English in a working environment
- Submit a statement to career services describing their motivation to do an internship
- The Career and Professional Development Program will take place in the Fall/ Winter/ Spring Terms and will be a 4x1 credit bearing course
- Comply with visa requirements

Academic Internship Criteria:

- The internship will be for 4 credits and can take place in the summer of the 3rd and 4th year of study
- The student will need to complete 160 hours worth of work to gain credit for the internship
- The student will need to submit a journal and a 2000 word paper at the end of the internship to gain credit

Other Internship Criteria:

- Full compliance with visa requirements
- No open balance with Hult

When in the academic year does the actual Internship program run?

- In the summer term in their 3rd and 4th year of studies

How long does the Internship last?

- If they can only work for 20 hours a week, they will need to work 8 weeks to gain credit.

How many Credits is the Internship?

- The Undergraduate internship is for 4 credits

Is the Internship Program Compulsory?

No, students must comply with the criteria and complete the mandatory Career and Professional Development Program

How does an UG student proceed to do an Internship?

- They will be given the option to register for the program in their third and fourth year of studies and instruction will be communicated to them via career services

Are there any preparatory courses before the Internship, if so when and how many credits

- Yes, successful completion of The Career and Professional Development Program in their 3rd year or 4th year of studies
